DEADLINE FOR VENDOR REGISTRATION IS May 10th. Applications received after May 10th will accrue a \$50 late fee; Applications received after May 24th will not be accepted.

Vendor spaces are 10'x 10' or the length of your food truck. Canopies must be kept within space allowed. Set-Up Time is 1:00 PM to 2:30 PM. Those who arrive earlier than 1:00 PM will be directed to wait. Spots will be assigned first-come, first-serve; we will not honor specific requests for spaces in 2024. All vendors will need to be set up by 2:30 PM.

The enclosed application, Vendor Liability Agreement, **and** Borough of Nazareth Solicitation Permit application must be completed and returned with a credit card listed on The Chamber's vendor application for acceptance.

Your vendor fee will be 15% of your sales from the day. A \$100 deposit is required to hold a space and that amount will be deducted from the percent of sales returned to The Chamber

Applications sent without a credit card listed or the Borough's Solicitation Permit will not be accepted. Your credit card will not be charged before the event unless you cancel less than 48 hours prior to the event in which case a \$150 penalty will be charged to the card listed on the application. Please be prepared with a printout from your POS system indicating your sales for the day. Your 15% fee and \$100 deposit for participation will be charged to the credit card on record from this POS Report. Alternatively, cash or check payment is acceptable with POS printout at the close of the festival. Cash and checks made at the close of the festival will be collected by a staff member of GLVCC at the conclusion of the event. Checks may be made payable to "GLVCC."

You will receive confirmation once your application is accepted via email. Approximately three to five days before the event, you will receive an email with all pertinent information for the festival, including intake instructions.

Electrical hook ups are NOT available for this event. Credit Card information is due at the time of application submission; applications are considered complete with credit card information and signature verification. Participants are responsible for bringing their own tables, chairs, tablecloths, display signs, tent weights, etc. Quiet generators (60 decibels or quieter) stationed on food trucks are permitted; loud generators (71 decibels or louder) are not permitted for the comfort of our festivalgoers and other vendors. Food trucks and vendors with trailers must unhitch their trailers for this event and remove vehicles from the premises. Canopies are required in case of rain or hot sun; tent weights are strongly encouraged. Vendors may not begin setup until entering through intake at or after 12:30pm and must be completely set up no later than 2:30pm. Vendors may not breakdown prior to 7:00pm.

2024 Nazareth Food Truck Festival Vendor Application (June 8th, 2024)

DEADLINE FOR VENDOR REGISTRATION IS May 10th. Applications received after May 10th will accrue a late fee; Applications received after May 24th will not be accepted.

The following items will need to be completed and submitted at the time of applying to be accepted to the festival.

- □ The Chamber's Vendor Application and Liability Form Page 2 and 3 of this document
- □ **Vendor Fee** 15% of food or alcohol sales (Complete credit card section)
- Deposit \$100 paid to The Chamber to reserve a space. That amount will be deducted from the percent of sales returned to The Chamber
- Late Fee \$50 This fee will be automatically applied if application is received after May 10th, 2024.
- **Borough of Nazareth's Solicitation Permit Application** With copy of photo ID
- Certificate of Insurance Listing the "Greater Lehigh Valley Chamber of Commerce, and its officials, directors, employees, and agents, and the Borough of Nazareth" as additionally insured. (Fee covered by the Chamber)

All food handlers must have a temporary hand-washing set-up and appropriate food storage (i.e., ice, coolers, etc.). All food handlers must wear disposable gloves. Food trucks and vendors with trailers must unhitch their trailers for this event and remove vehicles from the premises.

I, ________(vendor) understand that electrical hook ups are NOT available for this event. I understand payment is due at the time of application submission. I understand applications without payment will not be accepted. I understand I am responsible for bringing my own tables, chairs, tablecloths, display signs, tent weights, etc. I understand quiet generators (60 decibels or quieter) stationed on food trucks are permitted; loud generators (71 decibels or louder) are not permitted for the comfort of Food Truck Festival attendees and other vendors. I understand food trucks and vendors with trailers must unhitch their trailers for this event and remove vehicles from the premises. I understand canopies are required in case of rain or hot sun and that tent weights are strongly encouraged. I understand I may not begin setup until entering through intake at or after 12:30am and must be completely set up no later than 2:30pm. I understand I may not breakdown prior to 7:00pm.

BOROUGH OF NAZARETH SOLICITATION PERMIT APPLICATION HELPFUL TIPS

As noted in The Chamber's application, it is <u>required</u> that you turn in the Borough of Nazareth's Solicitation Permit Application to be accepted to the event.

Below, we have listed helpful tips for you to review when filling out the Borough of Nazareth's Solicitation Permit Application. Should you have any questions, contact Aaron Gasparetti at <u>AaronG@lehighvalleychamber.org</u> or Elyse Cuttic at <u>ElyseC@lehighvalleychamber.org</u>.

- The Borough of Nazareth's Solicitation Permit Application should be submitted to The Chamber. We will turn it in to the Borough on your behalf.
- A copy of a valid government-issued photo ID must be submitted with your application (i.e., license, passport, etc.).
- We understand that not everyone has a Sales Tax number. If you do not, in its place, you can list your business' EIN number or the last four digits of your Social Security number. If you are listing one of these, please make a note of "(EIN)" or "(SS)" next to that number so the Borough of Nazareth's Police Department understands that it is not a Sales Tax number.
- There are three criminal record questions. All three of these questions need to be answered or the application will not be accepted.
- You must list at least one vehicle in the "Vehicles Used" section of the application. This should be the vehicle that you are driving to the event or the primary vehicle you use for your business.
- All applications must be hand-signed and dated. E-signatures are not accepted by the Borough of Nazareth.
- Please note the box for initials indicating your compliance with Chapter 13 Ordinance Requirements
- Make sure that you complete the ENTIRE application aside from the area marked "Please do not write below this line". If something doesn't apply to you (i.e., Facebook page, website, etc.), we ask that you list "N/A".

Please note that in 2024, you will NOT need to pay a Solicitation Permit Application fee to the Borough of Nazareth. The Chamber will handle all Borough permitting fees, except Expedited Processing Fee, charged if a vendor would like to join the festival after the application due date is passed.

You will NOT be permitted to vend at the festival without the Borough of Nazareth approving your Solicitation Permit Application. As noted above, the Borough's application should be turned in to The Chamber along with your other application items. We will submit your Solicitation Permit Application to the Borough on your behalf.
